Advancement from this event based on numbers

1 boater and 1 co-angler advances from this event to the 2018 Federation National Championship From: Virginia and West Virginia

- Any big fish pots are on the side collected on site and handled locally
- **Payback is over 100% in cash and prizes in total, goal is to give the winner's enough money to make the trip to the FNC for the most part**
- Everyone gets a National Semi Final qualifier jersey for this event.
- 47 boats to account for \$9,400 in boater's fees, \$4,700 in co-anglers fees

National Payout Breakdown

75% payback to 20% of the field of anglers = (Boaters \$7,050, Cos \$3,525)

10% to states for expenses (Boaters \$940, Co \$470)

15% to Federation Championship (Boaters \$1,410, Co \$705)
