Advancement from this event based on numbers

1 boater and 1 co-angler advances from this event to the 2017 Federation National Championship From: **Massachusetts & Vermont**

- Any big fish pots are on the side collected on site and handled locally
- **Payback is over 100% in cash and prizes in total, goal is to give the winner's enough money to make the trip to the FNC for the most part**
- Everyone gets a National Semi Final qualifier jersey for this event.
- 28 boats to account for \$5,600 in boater's fees, \$2,800 in co-anglers fees

National Payout

75% payback to 20% of the field of anglers = (Boaters \$4,200, Cos \$2,100)

10% to states for expenses (Boaters \$560, Co \$280)

15% to Federation Championship (Boaters \$840, Co \$420)

Therefore 28 teams 20% is 5 places paid as follows

Total payback in cash & prizes **\$10,760.00**

Total 28 boater and co-angler entry fees collected \$8,400.00

Nearly 128% payback in cash and prizes at the event
