### TBF National Semi-Finals Payout & Advancement Sheet

#### Advancement from this event based on numbers

1 boater and 1 co-angler advances from this event to the 2017 Federation National Championship From: **California** & from **Arizona**

- Any big fish pots are on the side collected on site and handled locally
- **Payback is over 100% in cash & prizes in total, goal is to give the winner's enough money to make the trip to the FNC for the most part**
- Everyone gets a National Semi Final qualifier jersey for this event.
- 24 boats to account for \$4,800 in boater's fees, \$2,400 in co-anglers fees.

#### National Payout

75% payback to 20% of the field of anglers = (Boaters \$3,600, Cos \$1,800)

10% to states for expenses (Boaters \$480, Co \$240)

15% to Federation Championship (Boaters \$720, Co \$360)

Therefore 24 teams 20% is 4 places paid as follows.

Boaters pay 4 places

3. \$ 640.00
4. \$ 400.00

Co-Anglers pay 4 places

1. \$ 845.00
2. \$ 435.00
3. \$ 320.00
4. \$ 200.00

\$2,280.00 for 48 qualifier jerseys

\$ 300.00 plaques

Total payback in cash & prizes **\$9,480.00**

Total 24 boater and co-angler entry fees collected \$7,200.00

**Offers 131.5% payback in cash and prizes at the event**
