## TBF National Semi-Finals Payout & Advancement Sheet

### Advancement from this event based on numbers

1 boater and 1 co-angler advances from this event to the 2019 Federation National Championship From: Washington & Oregon

- Any big fish pots are on the side collected on site and handled locally
- **Payback is over 100% in cash and prizes in total, goal is to give the winner's enough money to make the trip to the FNC for the most part**
- Everyone gets a National Semi Final qualifier jersey for this event.
- 32 boats to account for \$6,400 in boater's fees, \$3,200 in co-angler's fees

### National Payout

75% payback to 20% of the field of anglers = (Boaters \$4,800, Cos \$2,400)

10% to states for expenses (Boaters \$640, Co \$320)

15% to Federation Championship (Boaters \$960, Co \$480)

Therefore 32 teams 20% is 6 places paid as follows

\$1000 Evinrude Bonus to the District Champion **BOATER ONLY** if Evinrude E-Tec 2012 or newer.

\$3,030.40 for 64 qualifier jerseys

\$ 300.00 plaques

Total payback in cash & prizes **\$12,030.40**

Total 32 boater and co-angler entry fees collected \$9,600.00

**Nearly 125% payback in cash and prizes at the event**
