Fish Limits	<b>Tournament Directors</b>	Boundaries
Largemouth and smallmouth Bass 12" inches and over. Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per person unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.	Loren Torok (208)661-5519 Lorentork3@gmail.com Site Hosts Idaho Bass Federation & Cascade, ID	Water behind or distal to the main body of water will be deemed off limits due to regulations on watercraft placed by the state in the following areas: North Fork of the Payette River (west most creek) water behind the tamarack falls fishing bridge, Lake Fork Arm water behind the (S-bridge) and Gold Fork Arm (East most creek) water behind the old roadbed/telephone poles is deemed off limits. <b>Tournament waters are OFF limits Monday, and Tuesday, prior to the event. Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday are practice days.</b> <b>Saturday and Sunday are competition days (Read the rules)</b> Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
